## Paper/Pencil Packets

All,

Governor Kemp announced the extension of Georgia's Shelter-in-Place order on April 8, 2020. As previously announced, Chattooga County Schools' students will not be allowed to return to their brick and mortar buildings. Therefore, the system's Digital Learning Plan and Paper/Pencil Packets will continue for the remainder of the school year.

In order to decrease the risk of exposure, beginning the week of April 13, we will change the schedule of Paper/Pencil packet pickup to **Tuesdays only**. Packets will be available for pickup from 9:00 a.m. -11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, and Tuesday April 28<sup>th</sup>.

In addition to this change, 7 days' worth of meals will be available for pickup on **Tuesdays only** and will be delivered by bus on **Tuesdays only**. (See related news release)
